DESCRIPTION

Papaya, Baked Grapefruit, Hoppy

Just like the name implies, brewing a batch of pFriem Double IPA takes twice the regular amount of malt and hops. That means each pint is brimming with doubly-rich aromas of fresh berries, notes of papaya and a malty sweetness. Just make sure to raise your glasses twice because a beer like this deserves a double cheers

HISTORY

Most sources point to Brewmaster and owner of Russian River Brewing Company, Vinnie Cilurzo, for inventing the Double IPA. Originally brewed by accident in the mid 1990s, Vinnie added too much malt to a batch of IPA and balanced it out with more hops. Nowadays, Double IPAs are known for big maltiness balanced by an enormous amount of hops. These strong beers range from 8-10% and are overflowing with hop aroma, flavor, and bitterness.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Rich and hearty burgers, French fries and complex pizzas. Aged cheddar cheese, aged meats, and pickled vegetables. Indian cuisine that is spice-forward, with balanced yogurt and cream based sauces.

KEY INGREDIENTS

MALT | Rahr Pale Malt, Simpsons Caramalt, Simpsons Crystal Light, Simpsons Crystal Dark

HOPS | Chinook, Mosaic, Citra, Nelson Sauvin, Equinox

YEAST | American Ale

TASTING NOTES

Copper hues beam off the bright white foam. Aromas of ripe stone fruit, strawberry, and blackberries. Bursting flavors of baked grapefruit, ripe papaya, with a touch of malty sweetness. Finishes with a hint of tangerine rind melded with resinous, hoppy goodness!
