BREWED WITH TOASTED RICE FOR A SLIGHT SWEETNESS AND A TROPICAL TOUCH FROM NELSON HOPS, THIS LAGER IS CRISP AND QUENCHING WITH A HARMONIOUS BITTERNESS. DESIGNED TO PAIR SEAMLESSLY WITH CLASSIC VIETNAMESE STREET FOODS, IT INVITES DRINKERS TO SAVOR MOMENTS WITH FRIENDS, JUST LIKE A BUSTLING SAIGON NIGHT.

INGREDIENTS

CMC Superior Pilsen, Weyermann Pilsner, Weyermann Vienna, Milled Rice

HOPS

Tettnang, Saaz, Nelson, Krush

YEAST

Lager

RICE, ORANGE PEEL,
GREEN TEA

HISTORY

Loyal Legion team member Ny Provenzano talks about her history with Vietnamese Lager:

Vietnamese Lager is all about food, family, and friends. Cruising the streets of Saigon on a motorbike, you will see countless examples of beer (bia) playing a crucial role in the social fabric of the city.

A friendly game of cards, with spectators in tow, and a case of beer propped up next to a table. Groups of people singing karaoke, sharing laughs, swaying to and fro to the tinseley sounds blaring out of tableside speakers all aided by cans of beer. But above all else, find anyone eating food and you will certainly see beer being consumed.

We wanted to embrace the tropical nature of this rice lager. In doing so we used toasted rice to play off some of the slightly sweet notes of Vietnamese Lagers and in order to embrace further tropical character we used a light hand of Nelson hops. The result is a very drinkable, slightly sweet, dry, slight notes of tropical fruit, and quenching lager to be shared with friends in copious amounts!

TASTING NOTES

Pillowly white foam on top of a brilliant golden straw body. Delicate aromas of toasted rice, orange peel, red plum and lemongrass give way to flavors of jasmine green tea, cracker, and white peach. Finishes crisp and quenching with a harmonious bitterness.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Vietnamese Lagers pair beautifully with traditional Vietnamese dishes: Pho, Bun cha, Goi cuon, Bun bo Nam Bo, Banh cuon, Banh Mi, Banh xeo, and Com rang. Any Vietnamese Street food will pair lovely as well.
